


RESIDENTIAL LIFE AT UWC

Living on a UWC school campus





If you study at UWC, you will learn as much from living with your classmates as you will from the classroom itself. You will see the world from different perspectives and develop skills to create a more peaceful, understanding and sustainable world.

Leaving your family to join a UWC school can be scary, but the unique relationships you will form in those two years will help you build a home away from home. Your closest friends for life might be people that you never even dreamed of meeting!



A UNIQUE RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL EXPERIENCE

All UWC schools offer a two-year residential school experience for students in their IB years, although some of our schools also have day students.

At most UWC schools, you will share a **room** with a couple of students from other countries. Your room will usually be part of a larger residence or boarding house, which is shared with other students. Living in the boarding house, there are **houseparents**, who are either teachers or staff members and are there to support you, so that you can adapt and thrive at UWC.

Sharing a campus with **teachers and staff members** means that your learning experience extends far beyond the classroom. Your teachers will also be on hand to support you if you need advice on an assignment or on your future aspirations and goals.

Your teachers and other staff members will also support your Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) activities. You might find yourself hiking with your science teacher or launching a community project with the support of the campus librarian.

In addition, every student is assigned a **tutor**, who is responsible to check-in on them during their time at UWC. The strong bonds you form with these trusted UWC staff will be as important to your UWC journey as the friendships you make with your fellow students.





FACILITIES

Though each UWC school is different, you can expect to find similar facilities on each campus - dining hall/cafeteria, a library, sports facilities, medical facilities, areas to socialise. Some campuses have a gym and/or swimming pool, while others have specialist music/arts facilities.
